

GRADUATION DAY CEREMONY 2025

(10th Batch under Autonomy) **June 28, 2025 (Saturday)**

As graduation day is a customary, which is to be conducted with the fullest sense of discipline, dignity and decorum, every candidate receiving the degree should maintain discipline throughout the function, the candidate may kindly note the following instructions.

Instructions to the candidates

- 1. Only candidates who have registered and submitted their Provisional Certificate (PC) applications are permitted to attend the graduation ceremony. All other candidates may collect their certificates in person on any working day.
- 2. Registration link will be made available on the college website by 16th June 2025 and due to limited capacity of the auditorium the registrations will be accepted on first come first serve basis, allowing a maximum of 300 candidates.
- 3. The candidates shall report to their respective Departments by **8.30 AM** and collect their CGM & PC with folders. All the Candidates with Proper dress code shall occupy their seats by **9.30 AM** in the **Auditorium**.
- 4. The Parents accompanying the candidates will be provided seating in Block-4 seminar hall and will have Live streaming of the event.
- 5. Mandatory Dress Code
 - a. **Male Candidates**: White Color (Dhoti/Shirt or Kurta Pyjama)
 - b. **Female Candidates**: White Color (Saree or Churidar with Dupatta)
 - c. **Convocation Robe** (Kanduva) will be supplied by the Institution for all the registered students at the respective department.

Only students who agree to adhere to the prescribed dress code are eligible to register for the Graduation Day ceremony and apply for the Provisional Certificate.

- 6. Usage of Mobile Phones is strictly prohibited inside the Auditorium. Taking the photos by individuals during the ceremony is strictly prohibited inside the venue. However, an official photographer is arranged to cover the entire programme and candidates can directly download from Google drive link provided through the website. Candidates are not allowed to enter into or leave out of the venue during the graduation ceremony proceedings.
- 7. Selfie corners are arranged at the different locations for taking the photographs.
- 8. Lunch will be provided for the Graduates and parents at the Day Canteen after completion of the programme.

Note:

The candidates will be restrained to enter the venue in case of any deviation in the above instructions.
