Principal welcomed all the stake holders and introduced Dr. J. Girish, Director Education to faculty members. Following points have been raised by the faculty members and initiated the discussion.

Points Discussions:

1. Director Education addressed the faculty and following suggestions were made..
 - a. Introspection about the value that an individual is creating by self-growth
 - b. Work towards getting NAAC A++ and achieve NIRF ranking less than 100
 - c. Two publications for each faculty is a mandate to get deemed university status
 - d. Need to accelerate and rap up the existing practices
2. Principal reviewed the points that were discussed during the last town hall meeting.
 - a. Change in the student's uniform i.e Formal trouser and shirt for boys will be implemented from the 2020 admitted batch onwards first year onwards.
 - b. Co-operative credit society general body meeting will be scheduled to take the feedback on the services.
 - c. On campus Mobile usage/Etiquettes/Dress code
 - d. NAAC SSR submitted, Team visit due.
 - e. Flipped class learning/online classes to be a part of blended learning.
 - f. Students industry ready-student to be made capable of learning new skills, career path concept/new age skills in R19 & R20 regulations.
 - g. Pre requisites needed with regard to the faculty publications and research initiative to get into the university status.
 - h. Whether faculty or student change is mandatory, otherwise we will fall back in the race performer.
3. Vice principal updated the admission status of 98% admissions and 363 students with EAMCET rank less than 25000.

4. Members discussed the importance of blended learning in the new normal and following are the points/concerns raised by the faculty members..
- a. Due to online classes the challenge was to understand whether the students have understood and followed the class.
 - b. As per the feedback learning and attendance has improved in the last one year, however the challenges were majorly in terms of network issues
 - c. More scope to follow students beyond class hours with the support of LMS
 - d. Importance of Finishing school concepts-learning beyond academics social skills/life skills/organizational citizenship.
 - e. Explore and come with suggestions of innovation in online classes making them more effective.



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
