- 2 Explained the confidential reporting mechanisms for students who may have experienced or witnessed ragging incidents.
- 3 Outlined the role of student representatives in promoting anti-ragging policies and ensuring that students are informed about the consequences of engaging in ragging activities.
- 4 Discussed how student representatives can collaborate with the Anti-Ragging Committee and other relevant authorities to address and prevent ragging incidents.
- 5 Discussed the legal consequences of engaging in ragging activities and emphasized the serious nature of such offenses.
- 6 Discussed whether there are mechanisms in place to protect individuals who come forward to report ragging incidents, including safeguards against retaliation.
