$$\text{Percentage per year} = \frac{\text{Number of courses having focus on employability or entrepreneurship or skill development}}{\text{Number of courses in all Programmes}} \times 100$$

$$\text{Average percentage} = \frac{\sum \text{Percentage per year}}{5}$$

$$\text{Average percentage} = \frac{4.6+4.8+3.8+2.7+2.1}{5} = 3.6\%$$

*The above listed courses are exclusively designed to contribute certain employability skills which are very much needed to enhance the employability on the top of the curriculum. The courses which are of more technical in the curriculum are not included in the above list though it enhances the domain specific knowledge.
